Christy F. Riviere, Principal Environmental Planner
Bay Area Air Quality Management District

Christy Riviere has nearly 20 years of professional experience in air quality and climate planning, as well as regional transportation, housing and land use planning. Currently, Christy is leading the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's effort to develop Clean Air Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area, which will include the Bay Area's first Regional Climate Protection Strategy. The plan will encompass all the various strategies the Air District will undertake to reduce criteria pollutants, particulate matter, toxic air contaminants and greenhouse gases from nine economic sectors. Christy holds two degrees from San Francisco State University, a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Science in Business Management.

Steven S. Cliff, Ph.D., Senior Advisor to the Chair
California Air Resources Board

Steven Cliff was recently appointed Senior Advisor to the Chair at the California Air Resources Board. Until February 2016, Dr. Cliff was the inaugural Assistant Director for Sustainability at the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). In 2014, Governor Brown appointed Dr. Cliff to Caltrans to make California a better place through a sustainable transportation system: cleaner, and more livable, accessible, and prosperous.

Prior to his appointment at Caltrans, Dr. Cliff was Assistant Chief of the Stationary Source Division (SSD) at the California Air Resources Board (ARB). As assistant chief in SSD, Dr. Cliff was responsible for development and implementation of the climate change program pursuant to the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006 (AB 32). In this role, Dr. Cliff oversaw the California Greenhouse Gas Cap-and-Trade Program and led the adoption of the Climate change Scoping Plan. Dr. Cliff has more than 20 years experience in global climate and air quality research and is a recognized expert on global air pollution transport. Specifically, his research on air pollution carried by winds across the Pacific Ocean has been the subject of numerous research and news articles. Dr. Cliff continues his work as a Research Professor in the Air Quality Research Center/Institute of Transportation Studies at the University of California, Davis.
